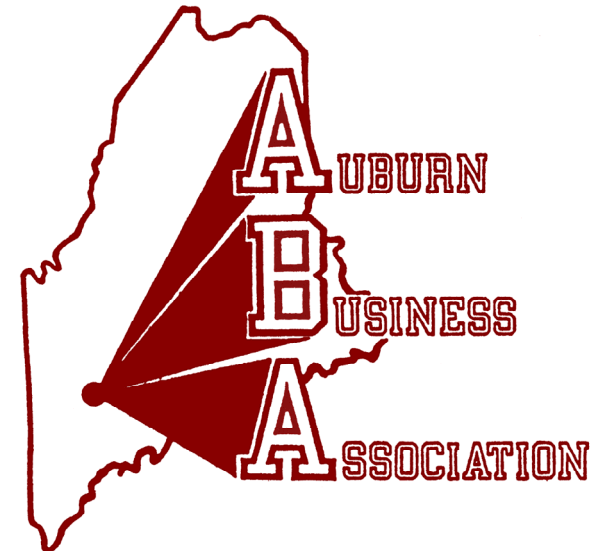
Membership is open to anyone who has a business interest in Auburn, Maine.
